## However

Barts Health NHS Trust, who run Whipps, are relying on improved **care in the community**, so are planning **51 fewer beds**. But our boroughs will grow by one-third over the next decade and social care is under-funded.

Barts is also planning that Whipps will specialise in **the care of frail and elderly people**. But it's an already overstretched hospital.
